### About Youth Career Connect

Brockton Area Workforce Investment Board (BAWIB) and Brockton High School (BHS) were awarded funding from the US Department of Labor to prepare students for high-demand Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) careers.

Youth Career Connect (YCC) is a grant program designed to bring together our public school district, local colleges, and the workforce development system to better equip students for college and careers. Specific industries of focus include Healthcare, Computer Science, and Advanced Manufacturing/Engineering.

#### Through out high school, YCC participants will:

- Engage in structured course sequences that lead to the accumulation of at least 12 college credits before high school graduation
- Gain exposure to high growth, high wage STEM careers
- Participate in internships, job shadowing, industry-specific mentoring, and other work-based learning activities
- Be immersed in cutting-edge, interdisciplinary courses with a focus on college and career success
