- Talked about the current BAWIB/partnership training programs
 - CDL partnership – flyer distributed / Ms. Albert shared with excitement another training opportunity for residents of our region sponsored by BAWIB, These are activities and training related to our Workforce Competitive Trust Fund grant program for instruction in CDL A (Commercial Driver’s License) and CDL B. Alternating between CDL A & CDL B over the next 18 months, looking forward to serving 24 individuals for this industry. Typical salary \$38,000 to \$48,000

 - Direct Care Worker Training -Flyer distributed
 - ✓ Small groups 8-10 people
 - ✓ Gave salary progression
 - ✓ 60 hour curriculum
 - Personal Care Aides

 - UMass Worcester will be conducting workshops at CC
 - 10-hour fundamental in December
 - CNA Programs – future trainings in 2017
 - ✓ Academy of HealthCare training
 - ✓ Potential – application submission – partners right now – per Lorraine
 - Virtual welding tool – hands on /end up with certification
 - Manufacturing – training last year – Level 101 /future pipeline training soon – will keep everyone posted.
