Questions and Answers

Q: What is your enrollment goal for the program?

A: The State has given us a minimum goal to enroll 113 young people in the program, but we have not had the opportunity to review the funding allocations and the BAWIB budget to determine the amount of young people we will serve this year. Last year we served about 160 young people. We would like to get as close to last year's goal as possible.

Q: There is no public transportation to Southeastern Regional Vocational Technical High School, but we would like to apply for internships, if students have their own transportation—can we participate as an internship site?

A: Yes, if the young people that are working for your organization can manage to find their own transportation and/or the organization that is applying for internships can provide transportation for the young people to meet the 125-hour requirement, they can be awarded interns.

Q: When will orientation take place for the organizations that are awarded?

A: Orientations(s) will take place at YouthWorks, on selected dates starting at the end of May through Mid-July. Awarded organizations will be able to -pre-register for the orientation. YouthWorks staff are willing to schedule one-on-one orientation for organizations who are unable to attend the orientation dates offered.
